

Communication Library and General Newspaper Archives



The Communication Library and General Newspaper Archives' main objective is to support the whole university community's teaching and research work, in particular the [Faculty of Communication Studies](#), the [Department of Journalism and Communications Studies](#), the [Department of Audiovisual Communication and Advertising](#), the [Department of Advertising, Public Relations and Audiovisual Communication](#), the [Department of Media, Communication and Culture](#) and the [Institute of Communication](#) (Institut de la Comunicació -INCOM).

The CEDOC is the Communication Documents Centre attached to the Library.

The building, located in the Civic Square of the UAB Campus, has a surface area of 10,500 square metres spread over seven floors. It currently has 582 reading stations, 13 consulting booths, 6 booths adapted for physically or sensory impairment, 12 group workrooms, 1 free-access workroom, 1 study room and 1 return drop box.

The Library houses 97,812 books, 14,366 theses and dissertations, 37,478 graphic and audiovisual documents and 10,795 collections of communication journals and magazines.

Access and consultation

There is free access via floors 0 and 4. The collection is free to access except for certain materials of restricted access or those in the Library's deposit. Check the [library map](#).

Sections

Books

Books are to be found on the 3rd floor. Most of them are free to access and are placed according to the Universal Decimal Classification (UDC). The main subjects are: communication, journalism, advertising, radio and television, cinema, documentation and photography. Also noteworthy is the extensive collection of reference works and the librarianship collection. This same floor also houses the leaflet collection and the local UAB monograph collection.

Newspapers and magazines

The free access newspapers and journals are to be found on floors 2 and 4 of the library:

Microforms

The microform collection plus a room for consulting these can be found on the 4th floor. Reference room opening hours during term time: from 9.30 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. and from 3.30 p.m. to 8.30 p.m.

Sound, audiovisual, graphical and I.T. material

Free access material of this sort can be found and consulted on the 2nd floor.

Most of the computers of the library can be used to access the UAB network databases, DVD and CD.

Reserve

The UAB reserve collection consists of an old document collection on general topics printed between the 16th and 20th centuries.

The CEDOC, on the 1st floor, is a collection of Spanish contemporary political documents.

Document acquisition

This service aims to control and manage acquisitions for the document collection.

Consulting and lending

To search for material in our collection you can consult the [UAB Catalogue](#), accessible using the computer terminals on every floor or from every other Library on the campus, and on the internet. It's also [available on your mobile phone](#).

Access to the UAB Libraries collection of digital resources through [Trobador+](#). UAB users access these resources from off campus through the [ARE Service](#).

Work rooms. On Floor -1 there are various workrooms (12 rooms for group work, 1 workroom and a study room). Consult the [Rules for using the booths and work rooms](#).

Lending. Bachelor students can borrow up to 8 documents, postgraduate students up to 16 documents and lecturers up to 35 documents.

Penalties for delay in returning documents shall be applied in accordance with the [Library Service Lending rules](#).

Consortium Loan Service (PUC). Free service that allows to users from a library member of the [Consorci de Serveis Universitaris de Catalunya \(CSUC\)](#) order and borrow documents from other CSUC libraries. Users of this service can order documents via web, through the [CCUC \(Collective Catalogue of the Universities of Catalonia\)](#) or in person at the library holding the document (in situ loan).

Instructions for users

At the beginning of the academic year, the Library organises a course entitled "Discover the Communication Library and General Newspaper Archives" for 1st year students, aimed at presenting the Library, showing the document collection for the different sections and providing information about its functioning and the services on offer. All 1st year students take the course as part of the subject *History of communication*.

The Library also organises courses about Mendeley Institutional, a reference manager.
