I found a reference to your society in a bibliography by Alan G. Thomas on Lawrence Durrell's works ("Lawrence Durrell" by G.S. Fraser, Faber & Faber, London) and I thought to write to you for asking some information about your activities.

I am the translator of many books by Henry Miller ("Tropic of Cancer", "Tropic of Capricorn", "Black Spring", "The Times of the Assassins", "The Books in my Life", "Reunion in Barcelona", "To Paint Is to Love Again") into Catalan and wrote a prologue to The Times of the Assassins, all of them published by Ayma, S.A. Editora, Barcelona, Catalonia.

As I am now working in an essay about Henry Miller, I would like to know whether you grant some kind of fellowship and, if so, the requisites to obtain it. The mentioned essay is written in Catalan.

I'd just be happy if I could travel to the States, visit the places where Henry Miller was born and lived, get some of his books not sold in Argentina, where I am living by now, consult his unpublished papers, see his paintings, listen to his recorded voice, etc. I corresponded briefly with him till some months before his death.

Would you send me any newsletter or broadsheets you issue about Henry Miller?
