**1. Objectius d'aprenentatge de l'assignatura**

This class proposes to wed linguistic theories, theories of language acquisition, sociolinguistics and aspects of the use of English (both locally and globally) in order to come up with a comprehensive outlook of how these factors influence the way we learn and teach English as a foreign language. Reflection and debate are key elements of the class.

For classroom management (not delineations in content), the class is divided into 3 modules: Language & Linguistics; Language Use; Linguistic Diversity. In each module, the role of EFL teaching within these three frameworks is examined.

NB: This list is not complete, nor is it linear, in other words, many of the topics overlap each other and it may seem that we are discussing items from Module III while still in Module I or vice-versa. This is inevitable because language and the study of language cannot be considered as a step-by-step process.

**3. Avaluació**

Assessment is based on continual assessment. The exact percentages of each activity will be discussed at the beginning of the semester, however, the all of the above activities will count. Assessment from your peers will also be part of the final evaluation. The final exam will count 35% of the final mark.

NB: If the continual assessment part of the course is passed, the student has the choice of sitting the final exam or taking the mark received during the continual assessment as the final mark. The final exam can

bring up the final mark. If the student has not passed the continual assessment of the class, the exam counts as 100% of the final mark.
