#### BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF SUBJECT

The goal of this course is to increase the students' linguistic awareness of certain areas of the English language, especially those which are markedly different from Catalan/Spanish.

### **OBJECTIVES**

By the end of the course the student should be able to explain and exemplify, using the tools learned, those aspects of English grammar covered.

### **SYLLABUS**

The major areas of English grammar will be covered, with a special emphasis on those areas where there are bigger differences between English and Catalan/Spanish: the structure of the NP; article usage; the verb phrase; uses of the English tenses; the modals, lexicalization patterns.

### ASSESSMENT

The course will be evaluated as follows:

- Final exam: 55%
- Paper + presentation: 35%
- Homework and in-class assignments: 10%

Note: The level of English will be taken into account when correcting written work and in the final assessment.
