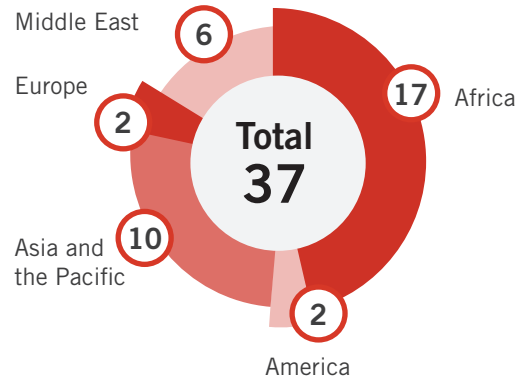
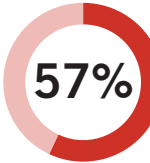




Armed conflicts in the world in 2024

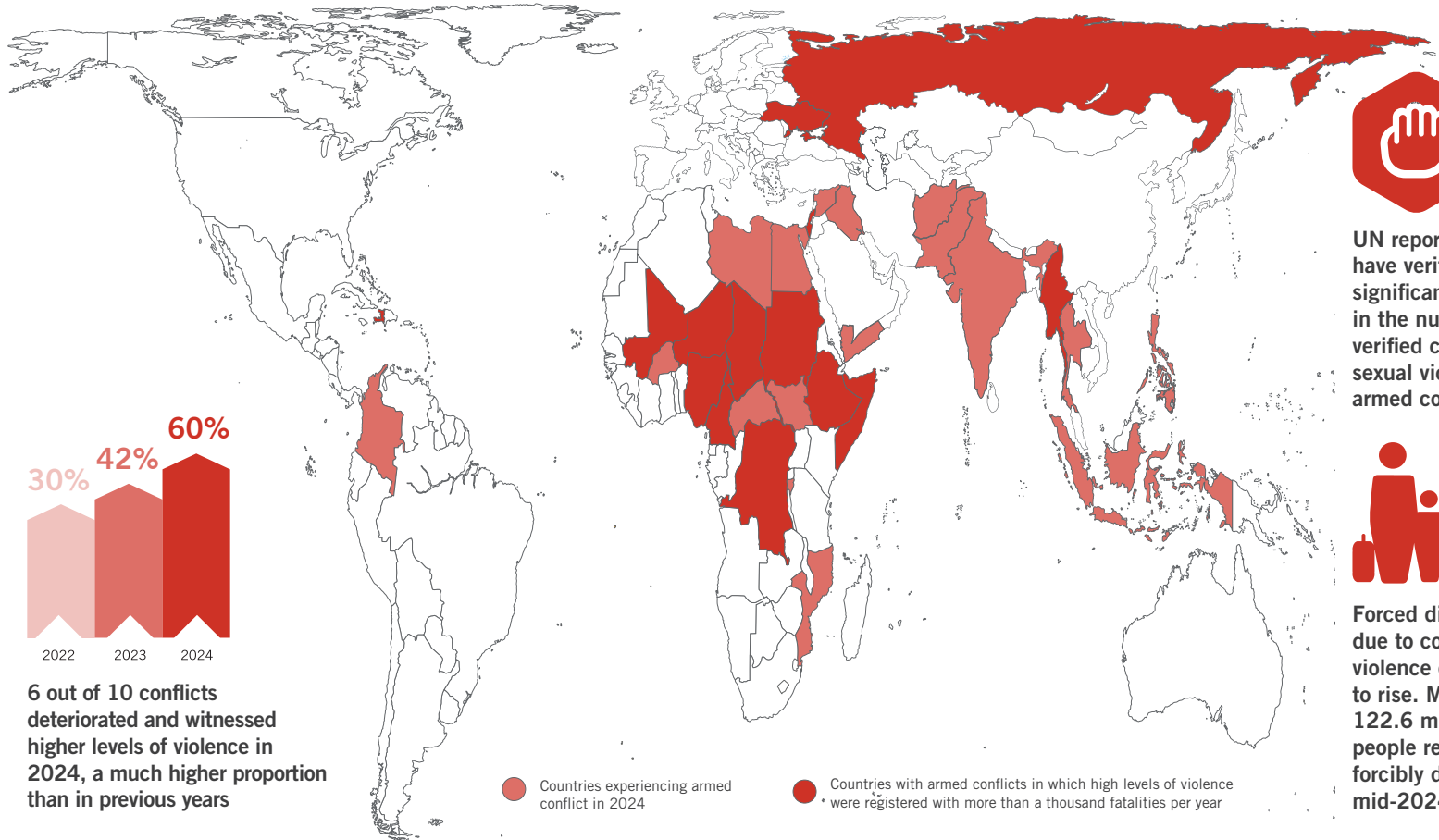
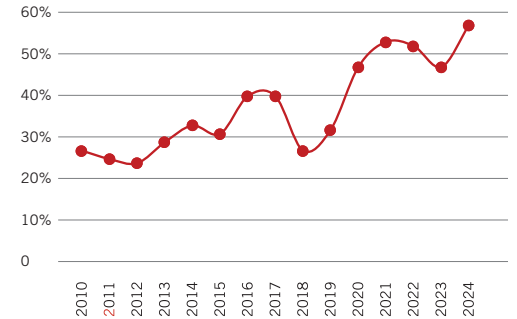


37 armed conflicts were recorded in 2024, the highest figure since 2012



More than half of the armed conflicts in 2024 (57%) were high-intensity, with serious death tolls and great impacts on human security

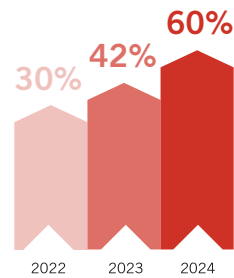
Since 2010, the most serious or high-intensity armed conflicts have increased significantly



UN reports have verified a significant rise in the number of verified cases of sexual violence in armed conflicts



Forced displacement due to conflict and violence continued to rise. More than 122.6 million people remained forcibly displaced at mid-2024 (UNHCR)



6 out of 10 conflicts deteriorated and witnessed higher levels of violence in 2024, a much higher proportion than in previous years
