


Conflicts and LGBTIQ+ rights in 2024



25 of the 37 active armed conflicts occurred in countries where ILGA had documented the enforcement of legislation or policies criminalising the LGBTIQ+ population, exacerbating the impacts of violence



76% of the high-intensity armed conflicts occurred in countries with legislation or policies criminalising the LGBTIQ+ population

The government of Georgia adopted a law restricting freedom of expression and assembly for the LGBTIQ+ population

In Iraq, Parliament approved the criminalisation of homosexuality through legislation with sentences of between 10 and 15 years in prison
