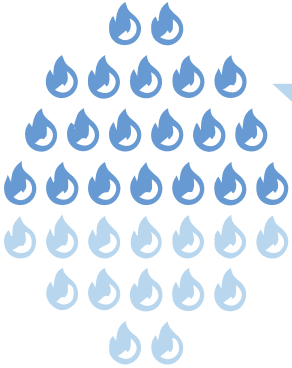


## Gender, peace and security



58% of armed conflicts (14 out of 34) took place in countries where serious gender inequalities existed, with high or very high levels of discrimination. This figure rises to 83% if countries with medium levels of discrimination are included

## Inclusion of gender equality in peace agreements

19.7% of peace agreements between 1990 and 2018 included provisions on women, girls or gender. In 2018 only 7.7% of agreements included them, according to PA-X database

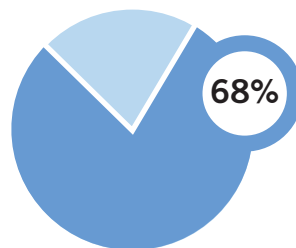

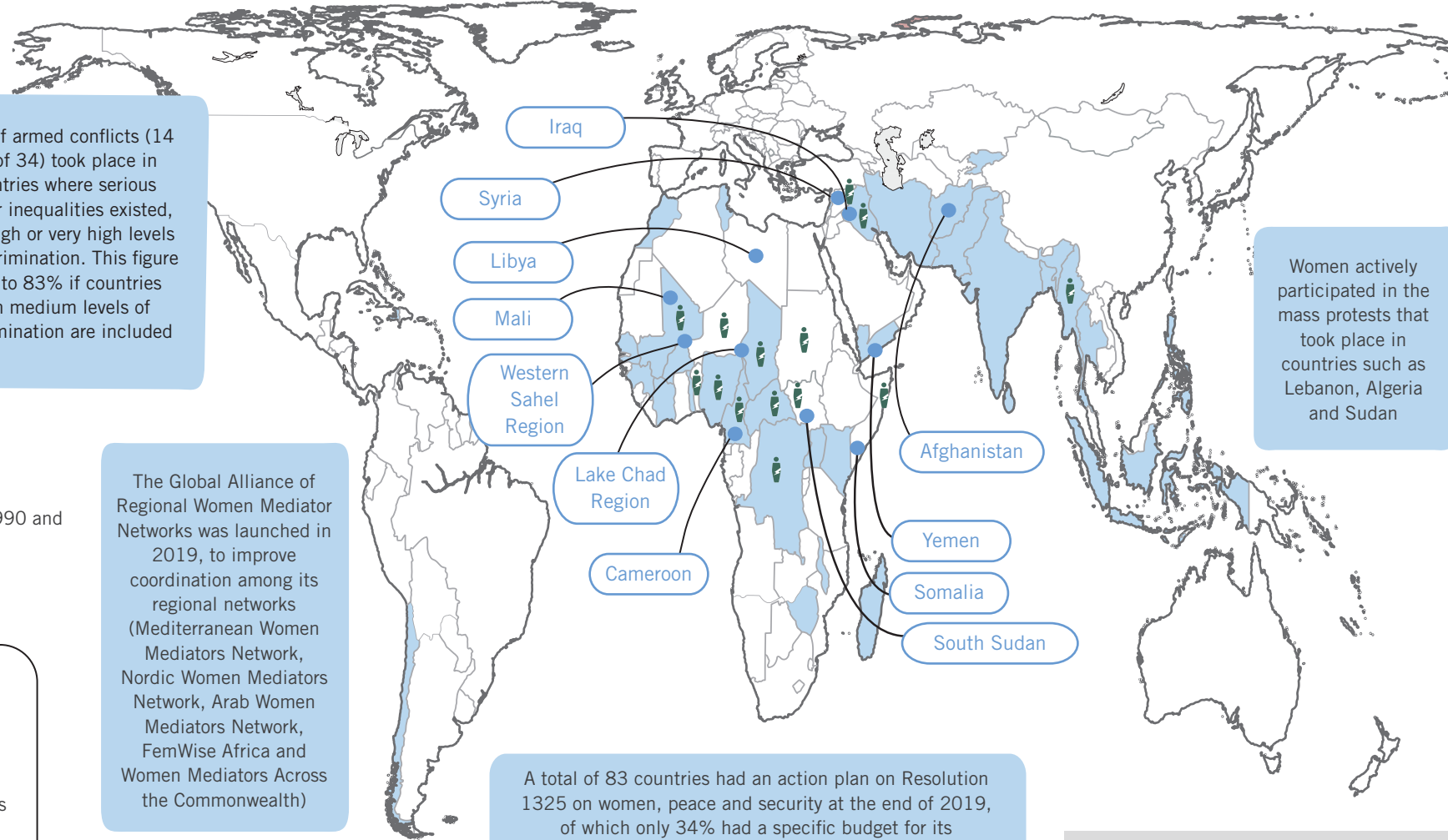
granted refugee status to applicants who were persecuted on the basis of gender orientation, gender identity or expression, according to the UN

The gender impacts of militarization and conflict on men included forced conscription of men in Crimea by the Russian Armed Forces

The Global Alliance of Regional Women Mediator Networks was launched in 2019, to improve coordination among its regional networks (Mediterranean Women Mediators Network, Nordic Women Mediators Network, Arab Women Mediators Network, FemWise Africa and Women Mediators Across the Commonwealth)



68% of the armed conflicts in 2019 (23 out of 34) took place in countries with discriminatory legislation against LGBTI population



Women actively participated in the mass protests that took place in countries such as Lebanon, Algeria and Sudan

A total of 83 countries had an action plan on Resolution 1325 on women, peace and security at the end of 2019, of which only 34% had a specific budget for its implementation and only 30% included references to disarmament, according to WILPF

- Countries experiencing armed conflict and/or socio-political crisis in 2019 for which gender equality data was available and that took place in contexts with medium, high or very high levels of gender discrimination according to SIGI
- Countries experiencing armed conflict with armed actors who are suspected of sexual violence according to the United Nations
- Countries experiencing armed conflict in 2019 with high levels of violence with more than a thousand fatalities a year
