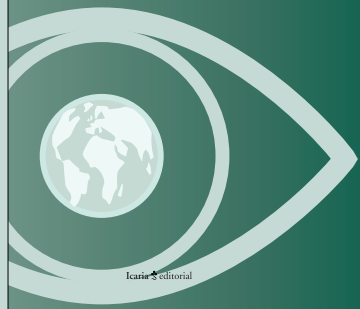
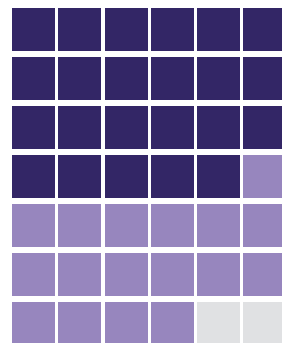

Gender, peace and security in 2025



23 of the 40 armed conflicts in 2025 occurred in countries with low or medium-low levels of gender equality



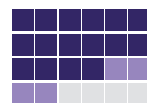
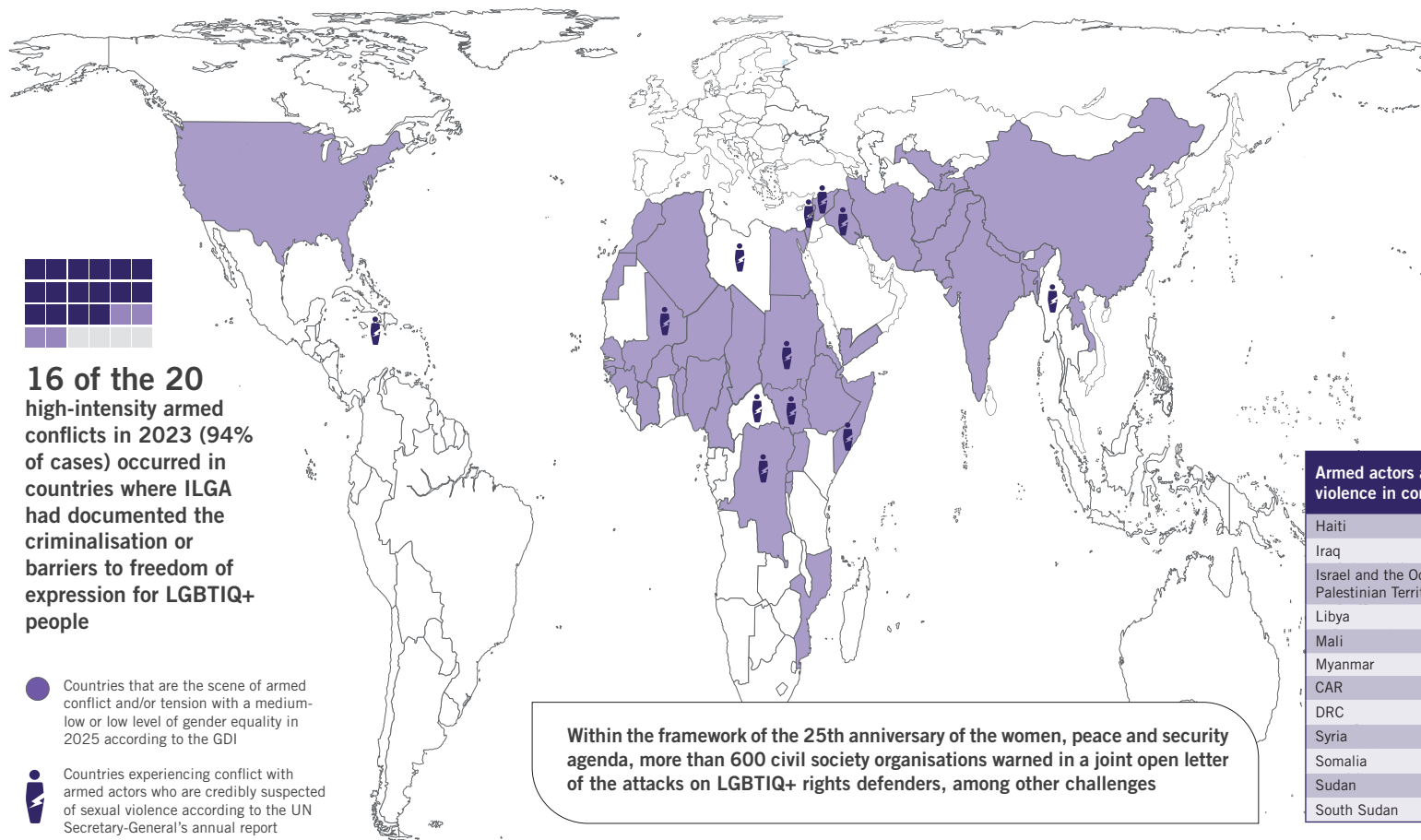
55% of the national action plans on women, peace and security included explicit commitments on women's participation in peace processes



The 25th anniversary of Resolution 1325 on women, peace and security was commemorated amid significant international setbacks in the recognition of women's rights



United Nations warned that global military spending in 24 hours exceeds the spending allocated to addressing sexual violence in armed conflicts



16 of the 20 high-intensity armed conflicts in 2023 (94% of cases) occurred in countries where ILGA had documented the criminalisation or barriers to freedom of expression for LGBTIQ+ people

● Countries that are the scene of armed conflict and/or tension with a medium-low or low level of gender equality in 2025 according to the GDI

● Countries experiencing conflict with armed actors who are credibly suspected of sexual violence according to the UN Secretary-General's annual report
