





## Conflicts and LGTBIQ+ rights in 2023



## 27 of the 36

active armed conflicts in 2023 occurred in countries where ILGA had documented the enforcement of legislation or policies criminalising the LGBTIQ+ population, exacerbating the impacts of violence in these contexts



Russia endorsed a ban on the "international LGBTI movement" classifying it as "extremist" and Putin's government stated that the war in Ukraine was also aimed at the defence of "traditional values"



Setbacks in the rights of LGBTIQ+ people continued to occur in Uganda, where the Parliament passed a bill strengthening the criminalisation of sexual relations between people of the same sex



Over the year, there was an intense controversy in Iraq around the use of the concept of gender and greater hostility towards LGBTIQ+ people was also observed
