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Dear Dr. Vicente,

In 1977 you published, together with our colleague J.-P. Mauries, on some cavernicolous millipedes from Spain, including Paratyphloiulus lagari Ceuca, 1971, and Paratyphloiulus sp.

I am at present revising a group of Julidae from south-east Asia, obviously related to Paratyphloiulus, and for this reason am interested in studying specimens of this genus, especially females. I have not been able to obtain an answer from Dr. Ceuca, and Dr. Mauries informs me that the material you published in 1977 is with you. May I borrow these specimens for comparison with my Asiatic ones? I am particularly interested in the female, because there are some important characters in the vulva which were not described satisfactorily by Ceuca.

Would you be interested in receiving a set of my available myriapodological reprints?
