Thank you for agreeing to study my spanish Polydesmoidea, which I enclose.  
The collection details for the specimen are as follows:

Cueva de la Juentica, from which the specimen was taken is part of the Rales cave system in the province of Asturias, Northern Spain.

The specimen was taken from a deposit of flood debris approximately 100 metres into the cave . Other specimens of invertebrates already identified have been found to be accidentally <sup>n</sup> introduced into the cave. It is therefore quite likely that this specimen was also accidentally introduced.

If there is any other infomation you would like to know I would be pleased to send it to you. The specimen you can keep as I will have no further use for it.
