## Locations

The library is divided into different sections: General Room, where you will find the books not included in special collections and the reference books.

The hall with the borrowing and information services counter and the photocopying / printer facilities (coins/OCE card and only card).

The Serial Room includes journals and magazines and the silent reading room.

Level-1 (Planta -1), includes the Mathematics, History of Science, Computing History (also PC equipped room for training courses) and the Reservation Sections.

Most of the collection is open access except the final projects which need to be consulted in the Thesis Room.

Please leave the books on the trolleys when you have finished.

To keep the library a pleasant place to study you are recommended:

- Not to reserve places if you are not there
- Remain silent
- Switch your mobiles off
- Do not eat, drink nor smoke

## Computer facilities

Our PCs are preferably to access the electronic resources the library is subscribed to, as well as the catalogue and databases. Some PCs will allow you to work with word processors and office related software.

A hardware devices borrowing scheme is also available:

- Laptops, with a borrowing scheme limited to the Library grounds for a period of 2 hours and possibilities to connect to internet through the wifi.
- USB devices, can be borrowed for a 7 day period, not renewable.

The room has several electrified desks and wifi available for users to connect their laptops.

## Reproduction of documents

Self-service photocopiers, printer and microfilm reading-reproducing devices are available. Please, use them according to the current legislation.

## Training courses for users

Vine a conèixer la teva Biblioteca (Get to know your Library): at the beginning of the academic year welcoming sessions are offered to new students where we explain who the library is organized. You can register to any of these sessions at the issue desk.

Other training courses are organised during the academic year to familiarise you with all the available resources: Information sources in a certain domain. Introductory sessions for postgraduate students. Timetable is open and will be set upon demand. Sessions last approximately 1 hour each. You can also check the availability of courses -that take place in all the campus libraries- on Refworks online research management and sessions on the multisearch tool "Trobador".
