Locations

The library is divided into different sections:

- Borrowing and information area with multimedia self-service tools (scanners, etc.), locker to charge laptops and TV magnifying reading.
- General room with books that are not of special collections and reference works (dictionaries and encyclopedias). You will also find the photocopying / printer facilities (coin / OCE card and only OCE card).
- the special collections room includes journals, maps, Mathematics, History of Science, Computing History and the Reservation Sections.
- plant -1, the training room and a place to study.

Keep a good work environment and therefore all the floor 0 is dedicated to working individually and in silence.

Most of the collection is open access except the final projects which need to be consulted in the Thesis Room.

Please leave the books on the trolleys when you have finished.

To keep the library a pleasant place to study you are recommended:

- Not to reserve places if you are not there
- Remain silent
- Switch your mobiles off
- Do not eat, drink nor smoke

Computer facilities

Our PCs are preferably to access the electronic resources the library is subscribed to, as well as the catalogue and databases. Some PCs will allow you to work with word processors and office related software.

A hardware devices borrowing scheme is also available:

- Laptops, with a borrowing scheme limited to the Library grounds for a period of 4 hours and possibilities to connect to internet through the wifi.
- the computers of the training room, you must go to the circulation desk to use it for up to 4h
- USB devices, can be borrowed for a 7 day period.

The room has several electrified desks and wifi available for users to connect their laptops. You can also charge the batteries in the electrified lockers, ask your key to the circulation desk.

Reproduction of documents

Self-service photocopiers, printer and microfilm reading-reproducing devices are available. Please, use them according to the current legislation.

Training courses for users
