

Access, consulting and opening hours

Free access. Consulting the library collection is of free access except the documentation located on the storeroom, which must be requested at the counters desks and that is brought each hour.

The opening hours are:

Social Sciences Library (Floors 0, -1, -2 and -3):

Consulting: Monday to Friday, from 8.30 to 21 h

Loan service: Monday to Friday, from 9 to 21 h

UAB Study Room (Floors -2 and -3):

It opens evenings, public holidays and weekends. To access you must show the ID card of any Catalan public university (ACUP).

Equipments and other services

Photocopiers/printers: there are self-service photocopiers/printers located on floors -1 and -2.

Wireless network (WiFi): your laptops can be connected to the UAB network on any library floor.

Access from abroad the campus: the Virtual Private Network (XPV) service allows UAB users to work with Libraries Service resources from computers off campus (www.uab.cat/libraries, *Remote access*).

Audiovisual materials and microforms: to consult them in the library, please enquire at Logistical Support and Information Point (reception).

To help you know where you are... Areas of the library

The Library has four floors (there are plans at the entrance and in all of them).

→ Social Sciences (Floor 0)

Books area: with specialist books, reference works and audiovisual material.

Periodicals area: you will find these ordered alphabetically according to title.

Statistics area: you will find monographs, periodical publications and databases with national and international statistical information, plus annual reports for companies, banks and savings banks.

Carandell Library: a collection specializing in economic history of the 19th and 20th centuries.

Services: information and loan, returning box, catalogues, databases, Internet, office software, a room for consulting microforms and audiovisual materials, booths for researchers, booths for disabled people.

→ Social Sciences (Floor -1)

1 open room for working in groups, 3 work rooms for small groups, 1 training room, self-service photocopyers/printers.

→ Social Sciences (Floor -2)

Books area (basic bibliography): with handbooks, reference works and legal forms.

Services: information and loan, self-loan machine, returning box, catalogues, Internet, office software, work rooms for groups, individual study booths, self-service photocopyers/printers.

→ Social Sciences (Floor -3)

Study room, legal repertories and journals.
