Introduction

Communication Library and General Newspaper Archives is one of the eight libraries that makes up the UAB Library Service.

Its aim is twofold: it aims to provide support to the professors and research members of the Faculty of Communication Science; it further aims to meet the general needs of the remaining university community.

Access to the premises

The building has two accesses: one connecting the Faculty of Communication Science to the fourth floor of the building and the other access is located on the ground floor facing the Plaça Cívica.

Areas and equipment

The library's surface is 10.500 sqm, and has 582 reading stations, 13 booths, 12 group work rooms, 1 free-access workroom and 1 study room, 70 computers, 15 audiovisual stations, 4 printers/photocopy machines and 1 return drop box.

The Library further has wireless internet coverage on floors -1, 2, 3 and 4 where users can both access Internet and the resources on the UAB network with their own laptop.

Contents

101.023 monographs, 36.097 audiovisual and graphic documents and 10.979 journal publications.

How to find a document

Look for the document you wish to find on the UAB Library Catalogue: www.uab.cat/bib/cataleg. Note the localization and topographic indicator in order to find the document. The signs and labels on the bookshelves will aid you on your search.

Services

On the Service Menu you will find all services available throughout the UAB libraries: www.uab.cat/biblioteques/services. Here we highlight some of them:

- **Loan.** In order to borrow material you need to be a member of the university community and you must have the supporting card. Undergraduate students can borrow up to 6 documents, postgraduate students can borrow up to 12 documents and

professors can borrow up to 35 documents. For late return of documents the penalties listed on the Rules for Loans shall apply.

- **Acquisition of documents.** The Library acquires all compulsory bibliography. Users may suggest new titles by using the Acquisition Proposal Forms which can be found on all service desks.
- **Information.** You may direct your queries to "Pregunt@: Libraries Information Service of the UAB" by using the form available at: www.uab.cat/bib/pregunta or the forms available at all service desks.
- **Training for users.** The Library organizes introduction courses for freshers as well as specialized courses on communication and press databases, on "Refworks" —the bibliographic reference manager—and "Trobador" —the metasearcher for electronic resources—.
- **Loans of Laptops.** Laptops may be borrowed for a period of up to 4 hours (renewable once for two further hours) to be used within the Library premises.
- **Connect from Off-Campus.** The Virtual Private Network Service (XPV) allows UAB users to work with the resources of the Library Services from computers located outside the campus. Follow instructions on the Library Services website (on Remote Access)
