

# Communication Library and General Newspaper Archives



The Communication Library and General Newspaper Archives' main objective is to support the whole university community's teaching and research work, in particular the [Faculty of Communication Studies](#), the [Department of Journalism and Communications Studies](#), the [Department of Audiovisual Communication and Advertising](#), the [Department of Advertising, Public Relations and Audiovisual Communication](#), the [Department of Media, Communication and Culture](#) and the [Institute of Communication](#) (InCom-UAB).

The building, located in the Civic Square of the UAB Campus, has a surface area of 10,500 square metres spread over seven floors. It currently has 523 reading stations, 20 consulting booths (one of them for priority use for people with disabilities and/or specific educational needs), 12 group workrooms, 2 free-access study rooms, 1 training room and 1 return drop box.

The physical collection consists of 223,050 copies (books, theses and dissertations, audiovisual documents and graphics) and 21,777 titles of periodical publications (newspapers, magazines and newsletters). Besides, it should be noted the digital collection, in constant increase.

## Access and consultation

There is free access to the building via floors 0 and 4. The collection is free to access except for certain materials of restricted access or those held in the Library's deposit.

## Sections

### Books

Books are to be found on the 3rd floor. Most of them are free to access and are placed according to the Universal Decimal Classification (UDC). The main subjects are communication, journalism, advertising, radio and television, cinema, documentation and photography. Also noteworthy is the extensive collection of reference works and the librarianship collection. This same floor also houses the leaflet collection and the local UAB monograph collection. The 2<sup>nd</sup> floor 2 houses the **comics** collection, the **video games** section and the **film and television** section, which contains dictionaries, encyclopaedias, anthologies and books on festivals and film history and criticism.

## Communication Library and General Newspaper Archives

### Newspapers and magazines

The free access newspapers and journals are to be found on floor 4 of the library:

- Spanish and foreign press
- General information and dissemination magazines
- District and local press from Catalonia, Valencian Community and Balearic Islands
- Supplements
- Local collection of UAB journals
- Journals specialising in communication
- Press on microfilm and on CD-ROM

Comic magazines are located on floor 2, in the comic section.

### Microforms

The microform collection and a room for consulting these can be found on the 4th floor.

Opening hours during term time: from 9.30 am to 2 p.m. and from 3.30 pm to 8 pm.

### Audiovisual materials

Free access films, TV series and documentaries are located and can be consulted on the 2nd floor.

### [UAB Rare books collection](#)

The UAB reserve collection consists of an old document collection on general topics printed between the 16th and 20th centuries.

### [CEDOC, Documentary Centre for Communication](#)

The CEDOC, on the 1st floor, is a collection of Catalan and Spanish contemporary political documents.

### [COMTEC Centre](#)

Space for experimentation, collaboration and creation, on the 2nd floor, for shared use between the Faculty of Communication Studies and the Library Service.

### [Video Games Service](#)

Space for experimenting with video games for educational and entertainment purposes, located on the 2nd floor. Equipped with various consoles and online gaming platforms. It is complemented by a section of specialized books.

## Services

### **Document acquisition**

This service aims to control and manage acquisitions for the document collection.

[Loan service](#). Check the borrowing terms and conditions in the [Loan service web page](#). Penalties for delay in returning documents shall be applied in accordance with the [Library Service Lending rules](#).

Consortial Borrowing (PUC). Free service that allows users from a library member of the [Consorci de Serveis Universitaris de Catalunya \(CSUC\)](#) order and borrow documents from other CSUC libraries. Users of this service can order documents via web, through the Cercador (search engine) or in person at the library holding the document (*in situ* loan). [Consortial Borrowing web page](#).

[Work spaces](#) The library lends **booths** and **group work rooms**, which must be [reserved online](#). Consult the [Conditions of use and loan](#).

### Library instruction

At the beginning of the academic year, the Library organises a session entitled “Meet the Communication Library and General Newspaper Archives” for 1st year students, aimed at presenting the Library and providing information about its functioning and the services on offer. The Library also organises courses about specialized information sources and about preparing the Final Degree Project.

### Obtaining documents

If you need documents from outside of the UAB Libraries Service, and they are not covered by the Consortial Borrowing service (PUC), these can be obtained using the [Interlibrary Loan](#).

### Reproduction, printing and scanning of documents

### Laptop lending

### Wireless network

On all floors of the Library you can access the Wi-Fi network from your mobile devices.

The Library offers, on the ground floor, a loan service of network cables allowing you to connect your laptop to the Internet through the UAB network as an alternative to the wireless network when this falls or is saturated.
