
HUMANITIES LIBRARY: General Guide

The Humanities Library offers its services to the Faculties of Education Sciences, Philosophy and Arts, Psychology, and Translation and Interpretation.

Its collection is formed by 470.448 books, 1.907 Cd-Roms, 8.351 videos or DVDs, 4.417 CDs, 3.805 microforms and 6.012 journal titles.

Opening hours

Monday to Friday: 8:30 - 21 h. For special building hours please consult the Library Service web (www.uab.cat/bib)

What you will find?

- **Areas for reading**, with 1.093 sites; with the recommended bibliography for the course and consulting and reference works
- **Rooms for group work and work stations**, with a computer terminal connected to the internet and an Office package that will allow you to carry out the course work
- **Room equipped with a projection cannon and computers** to rehearse your class presentations
- **Items you can borrow**: books, videos, DVDs, CDs... To be able to use the borrowing service, remember to have your student card with you. No material can leave the library without passing through the borrowing service!
- **50 audiovisual sites**, where you can consult, view and work with videos, CDs, cassettes, DVDs and microforms
- An **extensive digital library** where you have access to databases, electronic summaries, journals, digital books, doctoral theses, CD-ROMs and other digital resources.
- **Free internet connection**: The library has coverage throughout two buildings for those wishing to connect their laptop to the internet free of charge
- **Self-service machines for photocopying and printing**

How to find a book, a journal, a film...

Search for the item you want in the UAB Libraries Catalogue: www.uab.cat/bib/cataleg. Pay attention to the location and the shelfmark in order to find the item. Look at the floorplans and the signs on the shelves.

The Library has **two buildings**:

Library (Building L): where you will find the books, videos, CDs, DVDs, cassettes, Microforms, CD-ROMs and floppy disks

Floor 0

- Lending
- Internet connection and digital service room
- Cloakroom
- Mini-bar

Floor 1

- Room of formation of users room and presentations
- Books about: philosophy, psychology, religion, education, social science, anthropology, geography, archaeology, history

Floor 2

- Books about: art, photography, music, cinema, games and sports, philology, literature, primary education text books, children's books

Floor 3

- Asian section
- Books about music, cinema, theatre and sheet music
- Section specializing in language and thematic dictionaries
- Media library: videos, CDs, DVDs, ...
- The José Agustín Goytisolo Room
- Map Library and CAL

Journals Room (Building B): where you will find the **journals**

Floor 0

- Journals on: philosophy, art, geography, history, education, sciences, music...

Floor 1

- Journals on: religion, socials sciences, literature, children's literature, philology, psychology, classic studies...

On all the floors of both buildings they are **points for consulting the catalogue** and for consulting the digital library, **reading room and areas for group working and the Self-service machines for photocopying and printing**
