Opening hours

Mondays to Fridays, from 8.30 a.m. to 8.30 p.m.
Christmas, Easter, August: from 8.30 a.m. to 2.30 p.m.

Documents on loan

- Books: 7 or 14 days
- Videocassettes, CD and DVD: 7 days
- Documents marked with a **blue spot**: holiday periods, weekends and bank holidays

Borrowed document can be returned at any UAB library.

Documents not on loan

Those marked with a **red spot**.
Journals, theses, dissertations, reference works and old documents.

Documents that can be borrowed simultaneously

1st and 2nd cycle students: a **maximum of 6**.

Reserving documents

If you want a document which is already out on loan, ask at the lending counter for it to be reserved. The reservation can be also performed over the internet at: www.uab.cat/bib (**My account**).

Borrowing documents from other UAB libraries

If you want a document that is in another library, request it at the lending counter. You can also request it over the internet at: www.uab.cat/bib (**My account**). In this case, you must indicate what library you want to receive at that document. Then, you can return it at any UAB library.

Weekend documents must be requested from and returned to the library to which they belong.

Renewing loans

The loan can be renewed a maximum of 6 times consecutively, providing the document has not been reserved by someone else. The renewal can be performed over the internet at: www.uab.cat/bib (**My account**), by telephone and at the lending counter.

In accordance with Borrowing Rules, if the documents are not returned within the set period, the right to borrow will be lost for a period **1 day** for every day's delay, and **4 days** for every day's delay in weekend and overnight loans.

Borrowing documents from other catalan public university libraries

Loan in situ: all UAB users can borrow items of any catalan public university library. To do it, users must present there their UAB identification card.

Loan PUC: all UAB users can request over the internet all the documents of any catalan public university library at ccuc.cbuc.cat. You must indicate what library you want to receive at that document.

Users Instruction Service

Instructional sessions throughout the year:

- RefWorks, bibliographical manager
