### Presentation

The Journals Room is a section of the Humanities Library situated in Building B.

It has a collection of almost 6,000 titles of free access journals in different media formats, ordered according to the major areas of knowledge, and distributed over the two floors of the Room, following a correlative numbering order.

- 2 computer terminals with internet access.
- 6 computer terminals for consulting the UAB Digital Library.
- 5 computer terminals with access to the UAB Libraries Catalogue.
- 1 photocopier for orders (lecturers only) and 2 self-service photocopiers.
- 1 microform reading-playing apparatus
