What is the DDD?




The DDD is the UAB's Digital Repository of Documents: it collects, manages, preserves and disseminates the scientific, academic and administrative production of the University.

What can I find in the DDD?

It brings together an assorted collection in terms of medium, subjects and types of documents. The DDD assembles the journals published by the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB), the articles published by researchers and teachers, teaching guides, manuscripts and special editions digitized by the libraries, classroom resources, videos, posters, photographs, research works, course programs, personal and institutional archives and many other documentary sources.

Where and how can I access it?


You can access DDD at ddd.uab.cat

Everyone has free access to all DDD documents, except for some documents restricted to computers connected to the UAB network. These documents show this warning:  UAB restricted access

How to search



You can search by title, author, abstract, keyword, and even within the full text of the .pdf files using the pull-down menu.

If you prefer, you can limit the search to a given collection or collections by marking or unmarking the buttons located at the left side of the collections.

It is important to distinguish between the search options: **Search**  and **Browse** .

 The Search button retrieves the term or terms that you have looked up and presents the registers retrieved in each collection.

Then, the results can be limited by collection and number and can be visualized in different layouts.

The Advanced Search enables the user to search documents combining terms that appear in particular fields (such as author, title, subject, etc.) through the use of Boolean and proximity operators (and, or, and not).

For further information, you can check the search tips (ddd.uab.cat/help/search-tips).

 The Browse button retrieves those terms that are similar to the one you have looked up and sorts them in alphabetic order.

Virtual collections

Some document collections – such as the books collection, the posters collection or the video collection – contain a subsection called “Focus on” at the right of the screen where you can see a list of virtual collections that gather documents that share some common characteristic.

For example, the Books collection <https://ddd.uab.cat/collection/lilibres> contains several collections based on the procedence of the books, their characteristics or their subject topic:

- Customize your interface.
- Save the search results and create alerts. You can subscribe yourself to a search and it will be executed regularly. You can also receive the results via email or save them in one of your baskets in the DDD.
- Retrieve all the searches you made during the last 30 days.
- Create baskets. Baskets allow you to define specific collections of documents and store interesting records that you may want to check later or share with others.
- Add comments and ratings to the documents of the DDD.

User comments policy

You must have an account in the DDD to post your comments and reviews. Any comments that may be offensive or that contain advertising or spam will not be allowed. Shall these situations take place, the staff in charge of the DDD reserve the right to remove them.

If someone repeatedly fails to fulfil these conditions, he or she can be banned as an identified user.


Copyright

The documents of the DDD are subject to copyright and therefore their use is regulated by the Intellectual Property Law.

Some documents have Creative Commons licenses, so the author can determine whether to allow the copying, distribution, public communication, commercial uses or derivative works of his document, always with acknowledgment of authorship.

In these situations, the record contains a description and a small image identifying the license chosen.

For example:

 License which allows the copying, distribution and public communication of the work, as long as the original author and the University are quoted and no commercial use or derivative work is produced.

 License which allows any exploitation of the work, including commercial purposes and the creation of derivative works, which distribution is also permitted without restriction..
