




The Social Sciences Library Organization of the collection



The **Social Sciences Library** collection specializes in thematic areas such as Law, Economics, Politics, Sociology, Tourism, and Prevention and Integral Safety and Security. Use the Search Tool (https://www.uab.cat/en/libraries) to explore the book collection, check its location and availability, and see whether items are available in print or digital format.

Books

Most of the printed book collection, located on floors 0 and -2, is freely accessible. It is arranged according to the Universal Decimal Classification (UDC) and, for monographs on economics, according to the classification of the American Economic Association (AEA):

- On floor 0 you will find specialized books, reference Works and law codes.
- On floor -2 you will find handbooks and recommended reading lists.

Through the <u>Search Tool</u> you can also consult and read the e-books subscribed to by the UAB Libraries Service. To access them, you must log in with your NIU and password.

Periodicals

Most printed journals, located on floor 0 (*C. Socials – Revistes sala*), are freely accessible. They are arranged alphabetically by title and cannot be borrowed. You can consult the alphabetical distribution map, available in the room and on the shelves.

The <u>Search Tool</u> also provides access to the full collection of electronic journals. To access them, you must log in with your NIU and password

Statistical Archive

The **Statistical Archive** is a section specialised in statistics and statistical resources across various fields: economics, finance, demographics, healthcare, culture, environment, tourism, agriculture, etc. The archive is located in a separate area on the ground floor (**floor 0**) of the <u>Social Sciences Library</u>, next to the Periodicals Room, with another section in the Library's Depository.

The archive includes:

- Periodicals and monographs containing statistical data in print, microform, and digital formats: the organisation on the shelves follows the Universal Decimal Classification (UDC).
- Annual reports or publications from companies, banks, and savings institutions in both print and digital formats: the organisation of annual reports from companies follows a classification system based on economic activity according to the SIC (Standard Industrial Classification). Financial entities are organised using a sequential numbering system.

This special collection is complemented by the business documentation collection from the UAB Digital Document Repository.

• **Databases**: some with local access and most available via the Internet.

Restricted access collection

Part of the collection is not freely accessible and can be requested through the <u>Search Tool</u>. The requested documents must be collected at the information desk on floor 0:

- Documents located at C. Socials Dipòsit Ilibres: Most books can be reserved and borrowed. Other documents are not available for loan, but may be consulted on-site upon prior reservation
- Carandell Economic Lybrary (C. Socials-Carandell): These documents are not available for loan and can only be consulted upon request. For more information, please visit Carandell Economic Library website.
- Reserve collection:

A collection on several subjects located in the *C.Socials-Dipòsit llibres*, mainly comprising works from 1801 to 1939, as well as the Piquer i Jover Collection, which focuses on child protection and youth crime during the Franco regime.

A bibliographic collection of particular interest, including legal documents published before 1801 (Antiquarian), located in the Carandell Economics Library
