## Medicine and Health Sciences Databases



Systematic reviews and meta-analysis by expert groups. Synthesizes information from clinical health studies. It is what is known as evidence-based medicine.



International Classification of Diseases 11<sup>th</sup> Revision. The global standard for health data, clinical documentation, and statistical aggregation.



**Índice Bibliográfico Español en Ciencias de la Salud** (Spanish Bibliographic Index in Health Sciences). Database compiled by the [Instituto de Salud Carlos III](#) in collaboration with the [Biblioteca Virtual en Salud](#). It includes articles from more than 200 scientific and health journals published in Spain since 2000.



Bibliographic database produced by the U.S. National Library of Medicine. It contains more than 26 million references corresponding to 5,500 biomedical journals. International scope. Coverage from 1946 to present.



**PubMed** comprises more than 32 million citations for biomedical literature from MEDLINE, life science journals, and online books. Citations may include links to full text content from PubMed Central and publisher web sites.

## Multidisciplinary databases



Scopus is the largest database of citations and abstracts of peer-reviewed bibliography: scientific journals, books, and conference proceedings. Using sophisticated tools and analytics, Scopus generates precise citation results, detailed researcher profiles, and insights that drive better decisions, actions and outcomes. Coverage from 1970 to present.



A multidisciplinary, curated collection, Web of Science contains over 21,100 peer-reviewed, high-quality scholarly journals. Conference proceedings and book data are also available. The Citation Reports tool allows you see the citation impact for any group of work. The Citation Reports provide total times cited, average times cited, and the h-index. Coverage since 1945.
