Dear Dr. Tomas,

On behalf of the Director-General of the European Organisation for Nuclear Research, I have pleasure in offering you a position as a Corresponding Fellow.

You will be attached to the Track Chambers Division for a period of three months in a year for three calendar years 1968, 1969, 1970. Your first visit to CERN would be the period of 1.7.1968 - 30.9.1968.

It is our understanding that you will continue to receive full financial support from your parent institute and CERN will pay you an additional subsistence allowance of Sw.fr.2,100.- per month. Travel expenses for yourself for one outward and return journey each year from Madrid to Geneva, by tourist class air or first class rail will be reimbursed by the Organization.

You will, however, be under the general authority of the Director-General and be expected to fulfil all such obligations normally falling upon the staff of CERN as may affect the working of the Organization. In this respect, I would draw your attention to the annexed "Extract of CERN Rules" (Section I and III only) and "Conditions of Insurance".

If you accept this offer, please return to me duly signed, the enclosed copy of this letter and declaration.
