

Dear Mr. McGinley,

I was given your name and address by David Alton M.P. This committee was set up to co-ordinate the parliamentary work of its parent bodies, and I felt it was time that we liaised with you. I have of course read of your activities in the press. I should be very grateful if you would let me know what lines you are pursuing in your parliamentary work, and whether you see possibilities for useful co-operation between the Test Veterans Association and this committee or its parent bodies, which have a total membership of about four thousand, almost all doctors.

All we have done in this field so far is , following a meeting in May with David Alton, to send copies of the National Radiological Protection Board's protocol for its study to several specialists in the field who are members or contacts of ours. I asked for comments to be sent to David Alton and have received only one copy, from Mr. B.E. Lambert, Department of Radiobiology, St. Bartholomews Hospital, a copy of which I enclose.
