


CONTEXT



Experts' resource assessment

- **Content:** quantity, correction, adequacy, depth, usefulness, internal coherence, academic rigour (1-3 stars).
- **Formal aspects:** searchability, usability, clear structure, technical quality, ads, correctness of pinyin transcription, obsolescence (0-2 stars).
- Access: open access vs. payment (-1 star, if less than 50% materials are open access).















