The project:

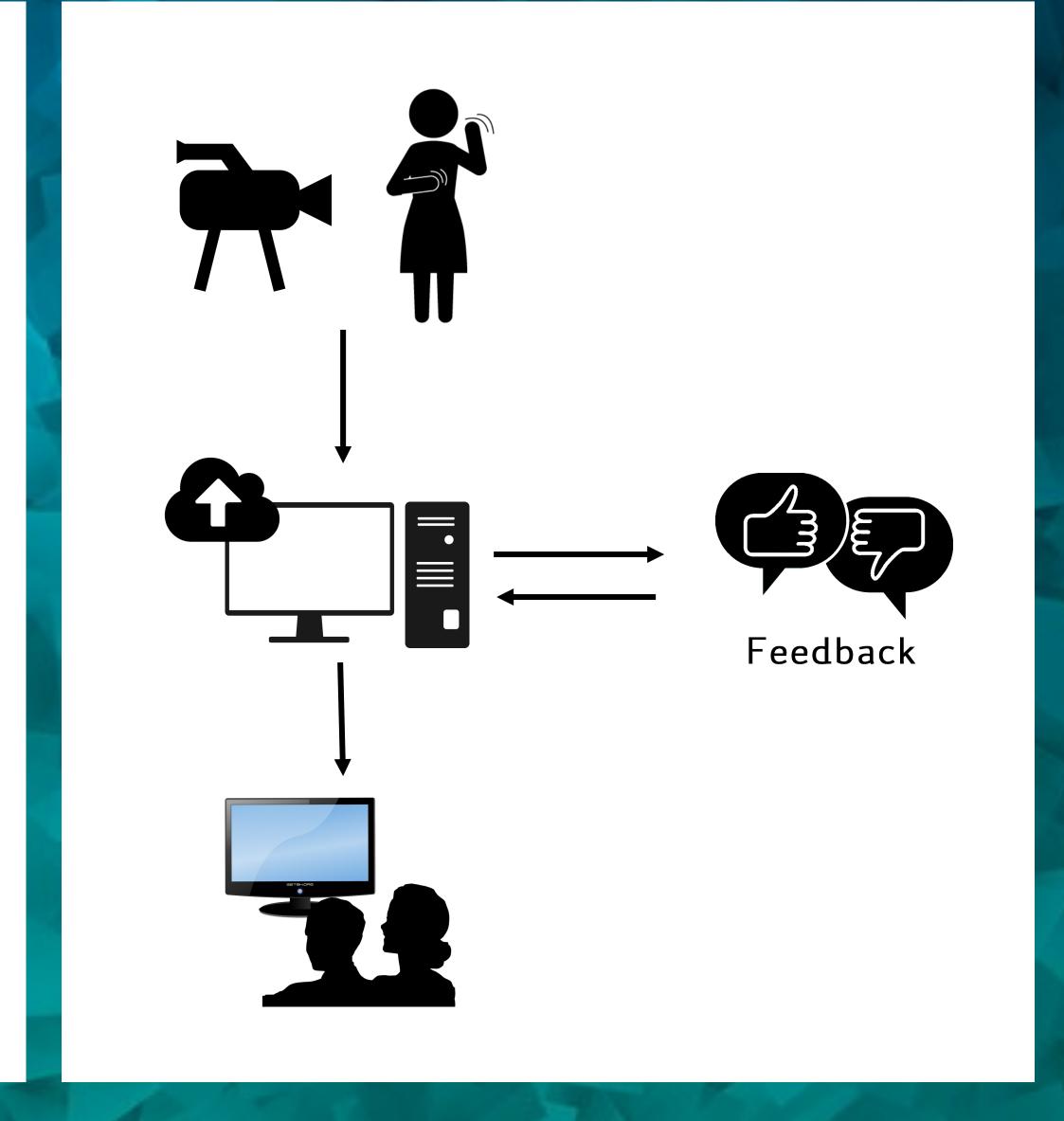
Creation of an online crowdsourcing platform to produce amateur Catalan Sign Language (CSL) interpreting of audiovisual content (children TV shows).

The rationale:

- 1. CSL is underrepresented in TV broadcasts (less than 500 hours per year).
- 2. Professional sign language interpreting is expensive.
- 3. According to Catalan law 17/2010, CSL has to be protected and promoted.
- 4. Subtitles aren't always a viable solution, especially for children and the elderly.

The process:

- 1. A prototype for a crowdsourcing platform will be created.
- 2. Users will upload their own interpreting of several pre-selected contents.
- 3. Users will be able to give feed-back to each other.
- 4. Focus groups will be carried out to find out user's opinions on the platform usability.
- 5. The quality of the interpreting will be tested by Deaf end-users.
