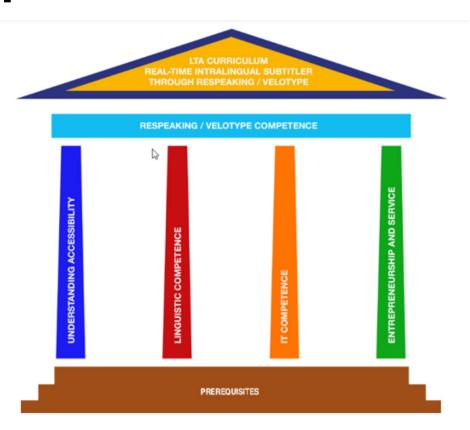

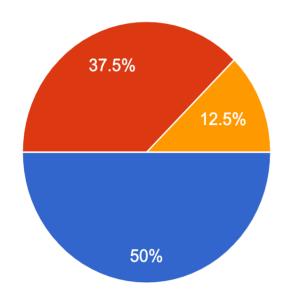

How satisfied are you with the structure of the course?



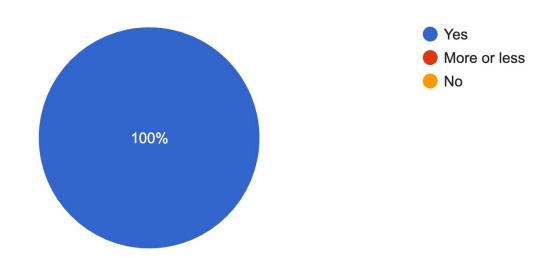

Do you think the overall structure of the course is relevant and covers the most important real-time intralingual subtitling topics?

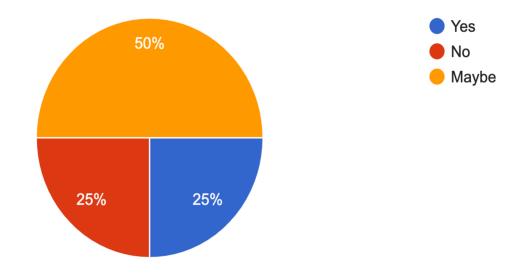

Would you prefer to take parts of the course only?

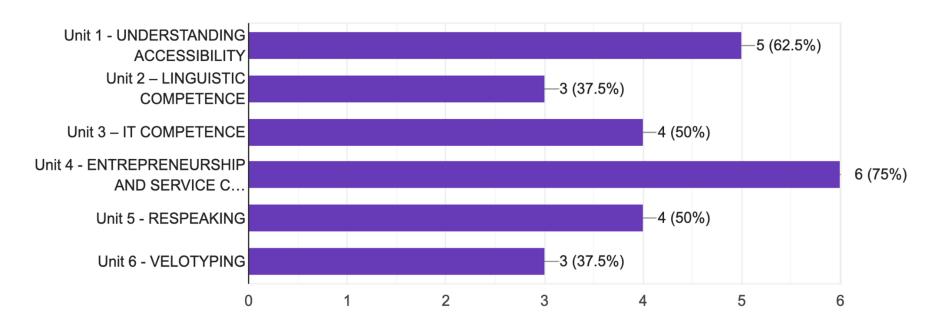






Evaluation of units

If "yes", or "maybe" which one(s)?

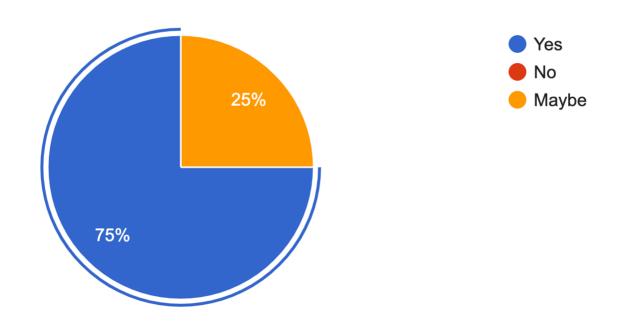






Satisfaction level
