



Conclusions

 Technology enables new ways of telling stories, e.g. by performing together remotely, allowing the creation of novel formats

• But:

- Technology must be human-centered and follow the artistic purpose: not used as fireworks
- Technology needs to be easy to understand and use
- It should be universal, accessible and inclusive
- It needs to be considered from the conception of the process
- Skilled facilitators are key for multi-disciplinary activities
