Mediaverse

- Open-source platform that offers tools and services to co-create content.
- Copyright & monetisation.
- Use cases
 - Citizen journalism.
 - Co-creation of 360º videos for social inclusion (migrants, students, persons with disabilities).
 - Artistic co-creation.

CROMA 2.0

- Fundació Autònoma Solidària (FAS).
- Face-to-face workshops to raise interest in learning and improve school linking.
- Children in socio-economic vulnerable situations, area around UAB.
- UAB volunteers offer mentoring.
- CROMA assesses proposals by research groups.

Hearing with your ears, seeing with your eyes

Aims:

- Becoming aware of the needs of persons with disabilities.
- Identifying solutions to make audiovisual content accessible.
- Co-creating a 360º interactive accessible video.

Also, provide feedback to the MV platform.

Methodology

• 1st stage:

- Preparation of the proposal (detailed documentation)
- Training the mentors (10 volunteers)

Methodology

2nd stage:

- Co-creation workshops: 8 sessions (66 children from 6 schools)
 - Sessions 1, 2, 3: video recording and getting familiar with 360 videos and cameras.
 - Session 4: You are my eyes. Audio description.
 - Sessions 5-6: You are my ears. Subtitling.
 - Session 7: Speaking with our hands. Sign Language.
 - Session 8: A video for all. Final video and discussion.

Methodology / Results

- 3rd stage:
 - Presentation of final results to other schools: one co-created interactive 360 video per school.

- Visit to UAB premises.
- Presentation.
- Three short activities to keep raising awareness.

Methodology

- 4th stage:
 - Evaluation by CROMA programme.

Evaluation by Mediaverse project.

Conclusions

 Impact of the activity on the students but also on the research group.

 Unique opportunity to transfer knowledge from a European project.
