Aims:

The aim of the C-3 language course is to develop the student's skills in distinguishing and production of different registers, genre and text types. Although all language skills such as confidence in speaking and listening comprehension skills will be touched upon, a special emphasis will be given to reading comprehension, summarizing and writing.

Description:

Students will work from articles from a variety of texts (press, literature or specialized literature) as well as from audio-visual material. Activities will include reading comprehension, summary writing, paragraph and essay writing, oral summaries and oral reports.

The course has 8 credits which will include 3 hours of class and 2 hours of designated work which will include a project and video work that the students will do on their own.
