### BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF CONTENT:

The purpose of the course is to extend participants' proficiency in English, by identifying the characteristics of a variety of recognized written genres, and giving practice in writing texts of these different kinds. Text types considered include the academic research paper, journalistic writing, and creative writing (a short story). In each case the linguistic characteristics and conventions of each text type will be made explicit, and will be applied in short practice writing exercises. For final assessment, participants will be expected to produce longer pieces of writing, corresponding to the three types considered. A theoretical perspective will be adopted when useful, but most of the time participants can expect to be working on the practical problems of text construction.
