METHOD OF ASSESSMENT: Two written papers.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF CONTENT:

The second language classroom is, in EFL contexts such as the present one, the place where English is both learned and used. Research in this area aims to understand how learning and use are constrained and influenced by the classroom itself. Classes are of course highly variable in nature, and the first step is to collect real data on particular lessons and classroom procedures. The aims of the course are thus, firstly, to familiarise participants with a number of observation tools which they can use for data collection, and secondly, to look at the kinds of research questions asked and the procedures involved in answering them.

BASIC BIBLIOGRAPHY:

A selection of reading materials will be provided.

OBSERVATIONS AND COMMENTS:

The course is practical and will require participants to conduct observations and research of their own, in schools off the campus. Class attendance is obligatory.
