BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF CONTENT:

This is an introductory course intended to provide basic skills for handling the responsibilities which teachers face in their daily work. By the end of the course students will have mastered a set of teaching techniques, should be competent to design teaching materials relevant to the four skills, and be able to critically evaluate published material.
