METHOD OF ASSESSMENT:

The final grade will be based on the following:

- final exam 50%
- in class and home assignments 30%
- mid-term tests 20%

The final exam will consist of a written and oral test. The former will include an essay, a précis, a reading comprehension test and exercises in error correction. The latter will consist of an oral interview based on a short reading of newspaper item. To pass the final exam, students **must** pass both the written an oral parts. If students fail the written part, they do not qualify to do the oral.

The assignments will be specified during the course by the instructor but they will include essays, précis, grammar and vocabulary tests and summaries of project presentations. Since any homework assigned and handed in will be graded and will count as part of the final grade, students will be given a 0 if they fail to submit the assignment promptly...hence the need to attend classes and turn in homework. There will also be a project to be carried out by students in groups, which will count towards the final assessment.

IMPORTANT: Students **must** pass the final exam to pass the course. However, students should note that by not scoring **well** on continuing assessment (=50% of the total course mark), they are highly unlikely to pass the course in June or September.

OBJECTIVES:

Llengua Anglesa II is a multi-skill 10 credit course starting at the Advanced Level, leading students up to a Proficiency level. The aim of the course is the development of aral and written competence in the English language, with an emphasis on the widening of vocabulary and grammatical structures.
