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BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF SUBJECT

This introductory course to the dramatic works of William Shakespeare aims at enjoying a few of his most representative plays: for the wide variety of their themes, his penetration into the inner chambers of the individual soul, his revelation of the dark mechanisms of power, and the expressiveness of his different linguistic registers.

We will read and comment on a Comedy, a History, a Tragedy and a Romance. If possible we can add a 'Problem play' or any other play chosen by the students.
