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BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF SUBJECT

This is an introductory course to the grammar of English. We will follow a descriptive approach. We will adopt a bottom-up approach and begin with the basic units of grammatical description and finish with the most complex ones.

OBJECTIVES

To make the students of the course competent users of the English Language. They will have to demonstrate competence in English pronunciation, in English word-formation and in English Syntax. Emphasis will be on correction and fluidity in the grammatical components.

SYLLABUS

The modules making up the course are:

- 1. Orthoepy of English
- 2. Lexicogenesis
- 3. Syntagmatic relations

ASSESSMENT

The course will be assessed on the basis of:

-A partial exam (a midterm assessment) on the theory dealt with in class, 30%

-A final exam on the rest of the course material, 30%

- -Class attendance and exercises, 20%
- -Two take-homes on two pieces of reading material, 20%

The Tutoria Integrada will be online. It will consist of the revision of theoretical aspects of the course reinforced with exercises
