BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF SUBJECT

This is an introductory course to the area of language comparison, language contrast and typology. Emphasis will be placed on areas particularly relevant of the contrastive analysis of English, Catalan and Spanish.

OBJECTIVES

The main objective of the course is to provide students with the basic tools for the study of the theoretical and practical analysis of the structural correspondences between English, Catalan and Spanish, and a working knowledge of typological studies.

ASSESSMENT

The course will be assessed as follows:
