**Objectives and Contextualisation**

This module gives students the opportunity to complete 250 hours in a public or private institutions linked to European issues. It aims at developing the practical implementation of the theoretical knowledge on EU matters by participating in real cases and tasks.

- Work in multidisciplinary teams.
- Work in professional environments that involve contacts with EU institutions and/or policies.

**Learning outcomes**

**Content**
