

#### Art:


- long texts,

# Some E2U principles

Unelaborated adjectives.

Opt for one-word items.



# Example

Highlight salient, necessary elements.

#### **Brushstrokes**


> «the marks of the brush made by the painter»





### Example

Sepals > «the outer part of a flower that surrounds the petals»





«The sunflowers are grouped in threes.

The sunflowers group around a central flower.

The central flower faces us.

Its middle part is orange and brown.

The petals are golden.

Some petals have fallen off.



The outer part of the flowers is pale green.

The style of the painter is unique.

The marks of the brush are lively»



- Ease of listening.

Listenability is not readability.

- Intelligible.
- Stimulating.
- Attention grabbing.




- Oral-based style.
