
The appointment as Research Associate is a regular appointment of the University of Chicago, described in Statute 13 (b).

Our Autumn Quarter session begins September 26, and this would be a good time for you to arrive, although it is not necessary and you will be welcome whenever you come. The Institute conducts seminars in theoretical physics and in nuclear physics which you could attend, and you could also attend any regular courses of instruction which seemed advisable.
