WORMWOOD subscriptions are \$5.00/4 issues/year to individuals and \$6.00/4 issues/year to institutions. There is a surcharge of \$1.75 for overseas subscriptions. Patron's subscriptions are \$15.00/4 issues/year with poet-signed center sections. Free inspection copies are not available because of our very limited press run. Copies of issues 16-23 and 25-84 are still available at \$2.00/issue post-paid. Microfilm volumes of the magazine are available from University Microfilms, 3101 N. Zeeb Rd., Ann Arbor MI 48106. Contents are indexed in Index of American Periodical Verse, available from Scarecrow Press, P.O. Box 656, Metuchen NJ 08840.

Because of the prohibitive postal/mailing costs these days, all subscribers are reminded that WORMWOOD is mailed out 2-4 issues per mailing. In a year's time, four issues are prepared, but they are mailed out at irregular times. The press cannot respond to library claims when the issues in question have not been released for mailing to all of our subscribers. Be assured that all paid-up subscriptions are guaranteed for delivery up through and including issue 96, the next index issue.

All manuscript submissions must be accompanied by the very necessary stamped, self-addressed envelope or by sufficient International Reply Coupons. Simultaneous submissions are not considered and WORMWOOD will not knowingly reprint an already published work. Reprint rights are re-assigned to our authors upon request, provided that authors acknowledge in further printings where the work first appeared. All manuscripts are read by the editor, but authors must not expect critical discussions of rejected work (WORMWOOD now averages about 2,000 submissions per issue). Rejected manuscripts are returned within 2-8 weeks of receipt. Since the magazine continues to be individualistic, it is useful for authors interested in submitting work to see a recent issue before mailing off their poems (latest issue: \$2.00 postpaid).
